

Minutes of State Archery of California Board Meeting
Discovery Park, Sacramento. Pacific Coast Championship.
September 20 2003

1. Awards –

- a. Doug Easton award - Terri will coordinate with the Creelman's in having the award engraved and mailed to the recipients. In the future the award will be issued at Outdoor State to recurve, male, female, adult. Tem will investigate a compatible award for compound and sponsorship.
- b. Stan and Denise Creelman will be responsible for all awards.
- c. Triple Crown - Will be awarded to the top Junior JOAD, recurve, compound, male female at PAC Coast. Top scores from Outdoor State, Cotton Boll and PAC Coast.
- d. Carl Radde – Most prestige JOAD award will be awarded in July by Carl. (if possible). Aletha will investigate having a field named after him. There were two JOADs up for the 2003 Carl Radde award, Jan Valdes and Miles Ross. After consideration, the Board voted to award it to Jan Valdes. Kevin will immediately publicize this award for 2004. Application deadline by May 1 2004.

2. State Rankings – John Juntunen will take responsibilities. On further discussion it was decided that SAC would give awards to the best ranked archer in each division, male, female, recurve, compound, including Yeoman to be awarded at State Indoor.

3. State Records – Aletha will record all State Tournament records following each Tournament. State Records and State Rankings will be posted in the next SAC Newsletter.

4. Membership Records – Individual Tournament Directors will give Tom Green all FITA registrations by Nov. 1 2003 and Tom will Submit to the NAA.

5. Membership Communications –

- a. Linda will activate data base and update E-mail address three times a year. (1.) After PAC Coast prior to indoor results by October. (2.) After Indoor results prior to Outdoor by February / March. (3.) After Outdoor results prior to PAC Coast by June/ July with an invitation to PAC Coast and send to Brooks.
- b. News letter will be sent out four times a year, electronic and paper. Tem will set dates. Newsletter will include Presidents

notes, Tournament registrations and results, calendar including Board meetings, club news, people news, SAC awards, State Rankings and Records, news section, photo section, note that Minutes are in the SAC Website. Tom will write an article on the Importance of the OR Round and insight. Kevin and Tem will edit and send to Brooks by Oct. 1 2003.

- c. SAC will offer Website and Newsletter facility for inexpensive bulk mail and E-mail to all (approximately all 700) SAC members to promote tournaments and news.
