

Minutes of State Archery of California board meeting.
El Dorado Park, Long Beach. California State Outdoor Championship.
May 17, 2003

Present- Alister Taylor, Aletha Donathon, Linda Collier, John Juntunen, Terri Matias, Tem Mills, Kevin Sliter, Janet Dykman (part).

1. Voting – Four vacancies. Retiring, Aletha Donathon, Alister Taylor, Patrick Creelman, Dan Roberts. Elections to be held Sunday, May 18, 2003 at the State Outdoor. Nominees are Tem Mills, Kevin Sliter, Alister Taylor, Aletha Donathon and write in. Terri nominated Alister Taylor for President, John Second. It was agreed that Linda and Terri remain in their current offices.
2. Distances – All Yeoman distances are to be consistent in all SAC Tournaments (15 and 10 meters, 122 cm. targets on day one. 15 and 10 meters, 80 cm. targets on day two.)
3. Awards – It was agreed to reinstate the Doug Easton Award, to be awarded to the top State Outdoor adult. Men and woman's recurve, beginning at the State Outdoor, 2003. Janet will bring an example to show.
4. JOAD of the Year Award – It was agreed to present the JOAD award at the PAC Coast Tournament to the top JOAD. (Recurve, compound, male and female.) Total of four awards, based on Cotton Boll, Indoor and Outdoor State and PAC Coast. Brackets same as number one State archer.
5. State Ranking – To be updated after each tournament by Linda and tournament directors. Linda will update the 2002 – 2003 by PAC Coast.
6. Records – John and Aletha will update and complete all the State records to the best of their ability.
7. Membership records – Linda will retrieve them from Dan and bring up to date.
8. News letter –
 - a. Alister and Linda will follow up with Brooks regarding the News letter and report by PAC Coast.
 - b. Next news letter to include State records and up coming tournaments.
 - c. Next news letter to encourage members to volunteer to help with local tournaments.
9. Tournament Announcements – All SAC tournaments have an official opening containing background and historical trivia regarding that venue mentioned.
10. Historical research- Tem was appointed to take responsibility for researching background and historical trivia for all SAC tournaments. Must have written report by PAC Coast.
11. OR round-
 - a. Kevin appointed to investigate OR round for next State Outdoor.
 - b. Anyone with adult distances may compete in OR round, i.e. female Cadet, Junior male, female.
12. Carl Radde Award – It was agreed to reinstate the Carl Radde Award. Kevin will assist Janet with research and develop a protocol for this service

oriented JOAD award.

- b. Qualification criteria.
- c. When application should be due.
- d. Judging criteria
- e. When award will be announced.
- f. When presented if brackets differ.
- g. Application form.
