1. Awards –
 - a. Carl Radde Award will be awarded at Outdoor State 2005. Discussions on details will be deferred to the next Board meeting, Indoor State, Tulare.
 - b. It was agreed the SAC will sponsor the Doug Easton and Triple Crown awards with a \$50.00 cash prize for each division, Male, Female, Recurve, Compound. The Triple Crown will be awarded at Indoor State
